This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Jagmit Singh, seeking pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case bearing FIR No. 138, dated 27.06.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran.

2. It is an undisputed fact that parties have amicably settled the matter and a written compromise has already been reduced in writing on June 28, 2014.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Harnek Singh has stated that in compliance of order dated May 26, 2015,

petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for further investigation in this case.

4. Taking into consideration all the aforesaid aspects of the case, order dated May 26, 2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
