ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in a case registered against him under Section 394, 397, 307, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Ambala Cantt.

The bail application filed by the petitioner had been dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala on 10.09.2014.

The State counsel had pointed out that the petitioner was a habitual offender and 19 cases are pending against him of similar nature and if he is released on bail he would pressurize the witnesses.

Heard.

A police party was on patrol duty when they heard the sound of a fire shot. The police party on hearing the alarm went to the spot and found three boys running away on the motorcycle. One of them was caught while two managed to escape. The person who was caught, was found in possession of a country made pistol who disclosed his name as Monu. He named the other boys, one of whom is the petitioner. A complaint was lodged by the complainant who alleged that the boys came on a motorcycle and snatched the bag containing money and they had fired from their weapons.

The petitioner had been named by a co-accused. The counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had been acquitted in most of the cases and had undergone sentence in some of them. The list containing the details of said cases was placed on record which shows that the petitioner has been convicted in a large number of cases and has been acquitted in 2 – 3 cases while some trials are pending. The allegations are of theft, dacoity and robbery. In these circumstances, no case for bail is made out. The case is at initial stage. The witnesses are yet to be examined.

The petition is dismissed.
