NAVITA SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No. 43 dated 25.06.2014 under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa, on the basis of compromise, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR.

In compliance with the order dated 16.01.2015, report from the trial Court has been received in which it is mentioned that parties have arrived at a compromise.

Learned counsel for the parties have stated at the bar that the matter has been compromised. The matter involved is personal in nature.

So, in view of the above circumstances and in view of authority reported as, "*Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others*" **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the above said FIR stands quashed. Further proceedings in pursuant to that FIR also stand quashed.
