Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.154 dated 05.07.2014, under Sections 302, 307, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54 of Arms Act registered at P.S. Ajnala, District Amritsar.

Role attributed to the petitioner is that he inflicted datar blow on the person of Simranjit Singh besides using abusive language towards Prabhdeep Singh. The injury to Simranjit Singh, according to MLR, is on the heel. According to Mr. Arshdeep Singh

Kler, DAG, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, the injury attracts culpability in terms of Section 324 IPC. Co-accused Amarjit Singh and Gurmej Singh have already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 26.03.2015 and 30.04.2015, respectively. Learned counsel for the complainant states that the roles attributed to these persons are only to the extent of exhorting/lalkara, whereas the role ascribed to the petitioner is that of inflicting injury on the injured witness-Simranjit Singh. In the present occurrence, Karanjaspal Singh died on account of injuries inflicted by Manpreet Singh.

Petitioner is in custody since 18.07.2014 and has undergone 10 months, 5 days custody as on date. The trial of the case may take some time.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.

Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM, Amritsar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
