Dis-satisfied with the investigation, petitioner-complainant has sought a direction to the official respondents that they may not pressurize the petitioner and his family members to withdraw the FIR regarding theft of his motorcycle and recovery of the money.

On the instructions of ASI Balwinder Singh, it has been informed that motorcycle has been recovered under Section 27 of the Evidence Act and has even been released on Sapurdari to the petitioner. The alleged money has not been recovered and challan stands already presented.

In view of above said circumstances, no directions is warranted, investigation being complete and challan having already been presented.
