Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition to enable the petitioners to take all the pleas available to them during trial.

However, personal appearance of the petitioners before the Trial Court, during trial, shall remain exempted subject to the following conditions:-

- i. petitioner shall be represented through counsel;
- ii. shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii. shall not dispute their identity as an accused;
- iv. shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel;

- v. shall appear before the Trial Court as and when required by the Trial Court;
- vi. any other condition which the learned Trial Court may impose.
