The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.'), has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.82 dated 12.09.2014, registered under Sections 328, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Rampura, Distt. Bathinda.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that no poison was detected as is evident from the medical record, Annexures P-2 and P-3. Further states that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order passed by this Court on 19.01.2015.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined

the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
