The instant petition has been preferred under Section 407 Cr.P.C. seeking transfer of Criminal Complaint No. 67 dated 13.11.2010 titled as 'Tej Kaur Vs. Gopal Singh and others', under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC from the Court of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Moonak to some other Court of competent jurisdiction.

The only ground raised by counsel in support of the prayer made in the instant petition is that the contesting party/ respondents herein are openly saying in their village that charges would not be framed against them and the complaint filed by the complainant (present petition) would be dismissed at the stage of framing of charge.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Suffice it to observe that such absurd ground can never form a valid basis for transfer of proceedings from one Court of competent jurisdiction to another.

There is no merit in the instant petition and the same is, hereby, dismissed.
