Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.255 dated 10.11.2007, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.1-State has been filed in the Court by learned State counsel. Same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the present petition may be dismissed as not pressed as the present case is for

quashing of FIR on merits. He further submits that while the present petition was pending for adjudication before this Court, the parties have entered into a compromise and a separate Criminal Miscellaneous No.M-23033 of 2015 has been filed for quashing of the said FIR on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 21.1.2015. The said petition is pending for 8.10.2015.

Considering the fact that the impugned FIR is the subject matter of quashing by way of compromise, the present petition does not survive and the same is dismissed as not pressed.
