Applicant seeks permission to place on record the copy of police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. as Annexure P-20 and also seeks exemption from filing the certified copy thereof.

Applications are allowed, as prayed for.

Both the applications stand disposed of.

Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of the judgment dated 02.05.2014 (Annexure P-19) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala and also the order of framing of charge as well as charge-sheet dated 14.06.2013 (Annexures P-17 & P-18).

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition.

However, he submits that learned trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same as early as possible, since the FIR is dated 28.07.2010.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Since the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner for expeditious trial has been found to be justified by this Court, learned trial Court is directed to make an endeavour to expedite the trial and conclude the same at an early date.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
