By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.128, dated 28.10.2014, registered under Sections 406 and 409 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It is contended that the petitioner is only a technical assistant and he was not associated during the verification of the stock. In pursuance of the order dated 18.05.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has

joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 18.05.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
