Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.88 dated 07.12.2014, under Sections 323/324/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Khajan Singh alleging that the petitioners as members of unlawful assembly consisting of 10 named and some unidentified persons had allegedly assaulted the complainant with 'dangs' and caused severe injuries.

Petitioners claimed that the matter has been compromised. The complainant also appears to have no grievance against the petitioners.

In this case, neither the challan has been presented nor the other accused, who were members of unlawful assembly, have been impleaded as party to this petition. No ground is made out for partial quashing of the proceedings on the basis of compromise.

This petition is dismissed, however, with an observation that it will be open to the investigating agency to record the supplementary statement of the complainant and drop the proceedings against any number of the accused on the basis of supplementary statement or other evidence.
