Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking direction against the official respondents to protect their life and liberty, at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed by the respondent authorities, they finally approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondent No.1 by way of self contained representation dated 7.5.2015 (Annexure P-2), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent No.1 is directed to consider and decide their representation, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda-respondent No.1 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioners, including the threat perception, raised vide their representation dated 7.5.2015 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same, at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
