Petitioners have sought quashing of complaint bearing No.COMI/1100285/2012 dated 4.6.2012 titled as Harpreet Kaur Vs. Jatinder Singh Lamba and others, pending in the court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, wherein they have been summoned to face trial.

Notice of motion was issued on the plea of the petitioners that petitioners are willing to settle the matter.

Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent, however, submits that there is no possibility of settlement of the dispute as both the petitioners are living abroad. Petition has been filed only with a view to delay the proceedings.

I find substance in the plea of the respondent. As there appears to be no possibility of amicable settlement of the dispute, there is no ground to interfere in inherent jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
