Counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition with liberty to move an application for regular bail before the trial Court and in the meanwhile he may be protected.

Earlier, co-accused Krishna Devi was granted interim relief and, thereafter, she was given time of ten days to file the application for regular bail.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for regular bail within ten days from today.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail by the arresting/investigating officer.

If the application for regular bail is not moved within the given time, the interim relief shall cease to operate.
