The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.276 dated 4.11.2014 under Sections 302, 147, 149, 427 I.P.C registered at Police Station, Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length and the pleadings on record have been perused.

As per allegations an occurrence is stated to have taken place on 4.11.2014 and Arbind Singh, who was working as General Manager in a hotel, had died on account of having been assaulted by 5-6 persons. Further prosecution version is that a marriage party had been held in the hotel and deceased Arbind Singh apparently had teased a girl upon which her relatives had thrashed him.

The present petitioner along with Timmy @ Hardeep Singh, Baldev Singh and Jaspal @ Palli have been implicated on the basis of a C.C.T.V footage.

The occurrence relates back to the 1st week of November, 2014. Allegations against the present petitioner are serious in nature. He along with co-accused is alleged to have resorted to beating Arbind Singh and

which has led to his death. The petitioner has not joined investigation till date and has been on run for the last almost 7 months.

Under such circumstances, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of pre-arrest bail. No infirmity is found in the order dated 1.5.2015, passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Ambala declining such concession.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
