The present petition has been filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 15 dated 12.01.2015, under Sections 147, 148, 380, 427, 452 and 448 of IPC, registered at, Police Station Old Faridabad.

Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused have been admitted on regular bail and the complainant has not produced any proof of articles stated to have been lying in the plot. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the petitioner is willing to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall be bound by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, Deputy Advocate General,

Haryana, has not opposed the submissions made by learned Senior counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above submission made by learned Senior counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is allowed. He is directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Office. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be admitted to anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He is also directed to comply with the provisions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
