This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 28.2.2014. However, while passing the said order, this Court had directed the trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably, within a period of nine months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order.

After obtaining instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, learned State counsel has informed the Court that the prosecution has since examined its entire evidence and now the trial is fixed for 15.2.2015.

Once the trial has reached its fag end, it will not be apt and proper to consider the request of the petitioner for the grant of regular bail.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition.
