**SABINA, J**

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.460 dated 11.11.2012, under Sections 279, 337, 304-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 148, 149, 302, 304 IPC added later on) and Section 61 of Excise Act, 1944, registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 20.05.2015:-

*“Originally, case was registered under Section 304-A of the Indian Penal Code along with other offences, but later on offences under Section 148, 304 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code were added. Some persons faced trial in that case and were acquitted. However, the petitioner along with Udhey Singh, Rattan Singh and Mehar Chand*

*was booked later on on some inquiry and report made by Superintendent of Police, Rewari.*

*Three persons named above besides the petitioner moved this Court for anticipatory bail and interim relief stood granted to them.*

*Notice of motion to the respondent be issued for 17.08.2015.*

*In the meantime, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed subject to the following conditions:*

*(i) He shall make himself available for investigation as and when required to do so.*

*(ii) He will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.*

*(iii) He will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police official.”*

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Mahender Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 20.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
