Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.202 dated 22.09.2014, under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Salem Tarbri, District Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated May 29, 2015 has granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners subject to their joining investigation and to comply with the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Jaswinder Singh submits that pursuant to the order dated May 29, 2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the aforesaid assertion, interim order dated

April 01, 2005 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and shall abide the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of.

It is made clear that nothing observed herein shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the learned trial court shall consider the case on the basis of evidence and material as produced before it.
