This petition has been moved by Surinder Singh @ Shinda under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.161 dated 25.10.2014 registered under Sections 394 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana.

Co-accused – Harjot Singh was granted bail by this Court on 12.5.2014. He was also in custody since 25.10.2014 as is the present petitioner. At the time of granting bail to the co-accused, it was mentioned in the order that three out of total 16 witnesses had been examined. It is submitted that the position still remains the same.

State Counsel submits that the main injury was attributed to Iqbal who is in custody.

Since case of the petitioner can be said to be at parity with Harjot Singh and his period of custody by now, is longer than the said accused, there is no reason to decline relief to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
