Two petitioners/accused are seeking regular bail in case FIR No.10 dated 15.02.2015 under Sections 307, 34 of IPC and under Section 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

The complainant-Parteek Kumar is the *Saadhu* i.e. husband of the sister of the wife of petitioner No.1-Mohit Kumar Bishnoi, whereas petitioner No.2-Prem Kumar is the nephew of petitioner No.1-Mohit Kumar.

The allegation against petitioner No.1-Mohit Kumar is that he fired shot from his revolver which hit the complainant on the back of the right shoulder, and the allegation against petitioner No.2-Prem Kumar is that he raised a Lalkara.

Learned State Counsel concedes that as per Custody Certificate, both the petitioners have been in custody since 20.02.2015.

It is contended that the dispute between the family members has been settled and the complainant filed his affidavit dated 17.03.2015, owning the amicable settlement between the family members.

Apart from the aforesaid compromise, the single shot was fired at the non-vital part of the body and the petitioners/accused are in custody for the last six months.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of incarceration of petitioner No.1-Mohit Kumar Bishnoi and petitioner No.2-Prem Kumar, this Court finds that they are entitled to be granted the concession of regular bail and as such they are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Fazilka.
