Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab. Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Petitioners, Saloo Devi and Harjinder Singh wife and husband have moved this Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on May 15, 2015 against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had moved an application (Annexure P-4) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to seek protection but no action has been taken by the Police.

In this view of the matter, Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-4) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of any matrimonial alliance of the petitioners.
