DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to take action against respondent No.5 on the basis of complaint and inquiry conducted on the application.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners made a written complaint to respondent No.2 on 15.12.2014, which was marked to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur for inquiry. Thereafter, the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur completed the inquiry and the file was sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur for taking appropriate action but no action has been taken thereupon so far. Learned counsel also submits that thereafter, the petitioner moved another application on 31.12.2014 for taking action on the inquiry but the

same is still pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioners also submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to respondent No.2 to take action on the inquiry.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take action on the basis of inquiry, if any, and decide application dated 31.12.2014 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
