Reply by learned State counsel in the shape of affidavit of
Ravinder Pal Singh Sandhu, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police,
West Jalandhar, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on
record.

It is submitted that every step is being taken to arrest the
accused in case bearing First Information Report No.86 dated
13.05.2015 under Section 365 of the Indian Penal Code registered at
Police Station Division No.5, Jullunder, District Jalandhar on the
statement of Munish Kumar. In that direction Investigating Officer has
obtained non bailable warrants of the accused for 07.08.2015 from
Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar on 23.05.2015.
