This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to petitioner in a case registered against her vide FIR No.108 dated 09.04.2015 under Sections 420/323/406/467/468 and 506 IPC at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa, Haryana.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Randhir Singh submits that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation. Otherwise also, pursuant to order dated July 20, 2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
