Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents no.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 to 7 and their relatives.

While the case was taken up for hearing, Mr. S.K. Arya, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents no.4 to 7.

Even petitioner no.1 namely Neha is also present in Court. She has also filed her affidavit, which is taken on record.

In order to know the wishes of petitioner no.1, Ms. Ashima Mor, Advocate, who is present in Court, has been requested to interact with petitioner no.1 to ascertain from her as to whether she requires any protection and she also intends to go with petitioner no.2.

Ms. Ashima Mor, Advocate has deliberated with petitioner No.1 separately in the chamber of this court and has informed the Court that petitioner No. 1 Neha is not inclined to go with petitioner no.2, rather she wanted to go with her parents.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners does not wish to press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, respondent no.2 shall take note of the fact that life and liberty of petitioner no.2 is protected.
