**RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)**

Petitioners seeks pre-arrest bail in criminal complaint No.1 dated 05.01.2012 titled as Narinder Singh Vs. Jagar Singh and others, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 IPC, pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties at considerable length and careful perusal of the record of the case, this Court is of the considered view that in the given fact situation of the present case, petitioner has been found entitled for the concession for anticipatory bail. It is so said because petitioner performed only his official duty and he was not the beneficiary. Jagar Singh was found having share in *jumla mushtarka malkaan* to the extent of 4 kanals 7 marlas, whereas he sold a piece of land measuring 3 kanals only.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further on merits at this stage, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, instant petition is allowed. Order dated 28.05.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.

Disposed of, accordingly.
