Prayer in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail in
FIR No.230 dated 04.09.2014 registered under Sections 323, 341, 308, 34
IPC at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

The allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he was
armed with rod and had inflicted rod blow to Nishan Singh on his head,
right side of his face and backside of his neck. Initially before the trial
Court, the petitioner was granted the benefit of stay of arrest during the
pendency of anticipatory bail application. However, it has been noticed by
the learned Court below in the order passed that the petitioner had not been
cooperating with the Investigating Agency during the period, he was
granted the concession of stay of arrest.

Considering the aforesaid aspect, I do not find it to be a fit case
for grant of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
