Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.21, dated 23.05.2013, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

In the light of the alleged recovery of 470 grams of intoxicating powder and which as per chemical examiner was found to be containing diphenoxylate, counsel appearing for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Petition dismissed as withdrawn.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner was arrested way back on 02.05.2013 and investigation having been completed, challan was presented on 15.11.2013, trial Court to make every endeavor to conclude the trial expeditiously and in any case within a period of 6 months from today.
