Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Jagdeep Singh in case FIR No.160 dated 24.11.2014 for offence under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana Rural.

As per the allegations, petitioner was going on motorcycle with Amandeep Singh and on witnessing the police party, he fled away from the spot. The police had recovered one and half gram of intoxicant powder from the motorcycle. Co-accused Amandeep Singh is already on bail as the recovery of intoxicant powder was of small quantity.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Bahadur Singh submits that the report of the CFSL is still awaited and the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 20.05.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
