RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

In compliance to order dated 21.07.2015, an affidavit has been filed by ASI, Gurmeet Singh endorsing that Rajnish Kaur wife of Hardev Singh is living in house No.747, Captain Wali Gali, Ajit Nagar, Aliwal Road, Batala, which has been owned by her husband Hardev Singh (petitioner).

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh states that in pursuance to orders dated 15.05.2014 and 28.08.2014 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined investigation. However, learned counsel for the complainant presses that petitioner has not facilitated recovery of gold ornaments. On pointed question, it has not been brought out as to whether any proof regarding entrustment was executed at the time of alleged entrustment of such gold ornaments.

Without embarking anything on this aspect, interim

order dated 15.05.2014 is made absolute. However, leaving the complainant to recover alleged istridhan in accordance with law.
