This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.61 dated 24.07.2014 under Section 304-A IPC (offence enhanced to Section 304/34 IPC vide DDR No.24 dated 25.07.2014), Police Station Jhander, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and also perused the paper book.

Petitioner's case is in parity with Rajbir Singh @ Raju who has been granted bail on 28.04.2015 by this Court in CRM No.M-12069 of 2015.

The main accused is Ravinder Singh as per prosecution story as observed in CRM No.M-12069 of 2015. Petitioner is in custody from 29.09.2014.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the fact that the trial will take time in conclusion, the instant petition is allowed and petitioner-Gursharanjit Singh be admitted to bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
