This is a petition seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal and departmental action against respondents No.4, 5 and 5A as also to investigate the matter properly and thoroughly.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated January 15, 2015 (Annexure P-9) was moved to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur but no action has been taken so far. Not only this reminders i.e. Annexures P-10 and P-11 were also served upon respondent No.3, which also did not fetch any fruitful result.

3. Notice of motion for official respondents only, at this stage.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to enquire into the allegations unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated January 15, 2015 (Annexure P-9) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case found some substance, therein, to take appropriate action against erring officials/private respondents.
