Respondent no.2 has not brought the draft. Learned counsel for respondent no.2 states that they have the bank statement with them to show the amount standing in their account. Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.5 dated 10.01.2014, registered under Sections 420/506/120-B IPC, Police Station Naggal, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 15.05.2014, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and have cooperated.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 15.05.2014 granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
