RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in an accident between Dumper and car he was seriously injured. FIR No.506 dated 12.12.2014 under Sections 279/337/427 IPC was lodged against some unknown persons and unknown vehicle.

Petitioner's car was badly damaged and he was also seriously injured. His mobile phone was also lost in the said accident. Thereafter Police put the mobile phone on surveillance track and ultimately one Rashid resident of village Dhauj was found to be having possession of the said mobile phone. Rashid disclosed registered owner of defaulting vehicle and number of vehicle.

The petitioner is alleged to have conveyed the same to the

Police and thereafter even filed representations in the context thereof. However till date no action has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Ripu Daman, A.A.G., Haryana., accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing reply at this stage.

Without commenting upon anything on merits, respondent No.2 is directed to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner and in order to ascertain truth he can evolve his own fact-finding mechanism.

In any case respondent No.2 would be obligated to decide the representation dated 12.03.2015 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
