The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.04 dated 29.04.2015, under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, registered with Police Station N.R.I., Jalandhar (Rural).

Reply by way of affidavit dated 03.09.2015 of Sh. Harinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division NRI, Jalandhar-II has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record.

As per the allegations in the F.I.R., the N.R.I./complainant has been sold of a plot of land whose ownership is not in the name of the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the said plot was inherited from his father and the same plot which has been sold.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Manoj Kumar, states that on investigation and verification, it has been found that a different plot has been sold which is not owned by the petitioner.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties, to complete the chain of the investigation, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
