Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.157 dated 01.10.2013, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Fazilka.

Following order was passed by this Court on 29.05.2015:-

“Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Krishan Lal submits that till date, no substantial evidence has come against the petitioner, however, case is still under investigation.

Adjourned to 03.08.2015.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for and he will also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Mukhtiar Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 29.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
