Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 186, dated 04.05.2015, under Section 323/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition. Learned counsel further states that complainant is more than 80 years of age. He further states that the petitioner shall surrender/appear before the Court and shall seek regular bail and his bail application may be decided expeditiously.

Present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner may surrender/appear before the Court and move application for regular bail. On doing so, his regular bail application be decided within two days in accordance with law, if not required for police remand.
