The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.21, dated 7.3.2015, registered under Section 306 of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press this petition and further states that the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail but the trial Court be directed to decide the same within any reasonable time.

I find this fair request. Resultantly, even while dismissing this

petition as not pressed, it is directed that if the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 21.9.2015 and move an application for regular bail, the same be decided on merits within five days.
