Learned counsel for the State on instructions from HC Gurbax Singh of Police Station, City Jalalabad, District Fazilka, very fairly concedes that in compliance of the interim directions granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.05.2015, petitioner did join the investigation and his further custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim directions issued vide

order dated 21.05.2015, are made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that if the petitioner does not cooperate with the Investigating Agency, then it will be open for the Investigating Agency to move an application for withdrawal of the present concession.
