Petitioner is an under trial in case FIR No.153 dated 17.06.2013 under Sections 22, 25, 61 & 85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Paatrha, District Patiala.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail due to cancellation of bail bonds on account of her non appearance on a single date.

This Court while issuing notice of motion vide order dated 21.5.2015 had permitted the petitioner to surrender and seek interim bail.

At the time of hearing today, learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh states that the interim bail on furnishing of fresh bail bonds with heavy sureties has been granted by the learned trial Court.

In view of the aforesaid stand, interim bail so granted by the

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trial Court is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
