Two separate petitions have been filed, one by Romins Kumar @ Romi and Varinder Singh @ Mani and other by Kuldeep Singh seeking regular bail in FIR No.158 dated 26.07.2014, registered under Sections 384 read with Section 34 IPC, Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are in custody for over nine months and the trial is not proceeding and bail had been allowed to Dalip.

On the last date, it had been stated that the complainant had not

been examined yet.

Charge has been framed in January 2015 and no evidence had been recorded. The trial will take long. Without commenting on the merits of the case, petitions are allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
