FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 21.9.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Vishal Sharma, Vijay Kumar Sharma, Usha Sharma, Komal Sharma as well as of complainant Monika Sharma it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that being a pure matrimonial dispute this compromise will go a long way to settle their future life and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.128 dated 4.12.2013 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 506 IPC registered at Police Station,

Mahila Police, Patiala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners. However, learned counsel for the complainant-wife made a request that a sum of ₹4 lacs which are lying deposit in the Court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, Matrimonial Court, Patiala may be ordered to be released to the complainant-wife in terms of this compromise. Prayer is allowed. Concerned Court is directed to release the amount to the complainant-wife, Monika Sharma on proper identification.

Petition stands disposed off.
