**NAVITA SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner has sought bail in FIR No. 64 dated 08.03.2014 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code of Police Station Tripuri Town, District Patiala, in which she along with Malkit Singh and Manpreet Singh is the accused.

The allegations are that Malkit Singh had got sale deed of land belonging to Gurmail Kaur executed in favour of the complainant and at that time Gurmail Kaur was not present. The petitioner had impersonated the actual owner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the other accused Malkit Singh and Manpreet Singh are already on bail. Copies of the orders granting bail to said persons by Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, are placed on record.

It is further submitted that the petitioner is HIV positive and

undergoing treatment at Rajendera Hospital, Patiala. She is in custody since 04.04.2015.

Counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner being the main accused should not be granted bail and if she needs treatment, she can be treated in the jail or if she needs any specialised treatment, she can be treated as an under-trial in Rajendera Hospital and can be taken there by the jail authorities.

Charges even have not been drawn up in the matter and it is stated that the case before the trial Court is fixed for today for framing of charges. The co-accused are on bail and the petitioner is ailing. Copy of medical record has been shown which has been seen and returned. The trial has yet not started.

In view of the facts enumerated above, the request of the petitioner for bail is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Area/Duty Magistrate.
