JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner/husband in case FIR No.73 dated 26.03.2015, under Sections 498-A, 506, 323, 354, 406, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat.

The marriage between the petitioner/husband and the complainant/wife-Anju was solemnized on 25.11.2008.

As per the allegations, the petitioner/husband along with his family members has caused acute harassment to the respondent/wife on account of dowry demands, resulting into the complainant going in severe depression since July, 2011.

The mediation proceedings have failed.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar, states that although the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, there is still recovery of huge number of dowry articles to be made.

After hearing learned Counsel for the parties and keeping in view the nature and gravity of the alleged offence having been committed by the petitioner, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
