The instant petition was filed for quashing of notice dated 29.04.2015 (Annexure-P14) issued by respondent No.3-Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police City-II, Amritsar on the application given by respondent No.5.

Reply in the shape of affidavit of Kawaldeep Kaur, Assistant Commissioner of Police (North), Amritsar, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, filed by learned State counsel in Court today is taken on record. In para No.2 of the reply, it has been specifically mentioned by the said respondents that notice Annexure-P14 issued by respondent No.3 has already been considered as null and void. It has also been mentioned in the reply that after completion of investigation, challan had been presented in the court on 04.09.2010.

The only relief sought by the petitioner in the present petition was quashing of notice dated 29.04.2015 (Annexure-P14). Since the respondents have stated that the said notice has already been considered as null and void the prayer of the petitioner stands satisfied and no further action is required to be taken. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
