JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 561, dated 23.12.2013, under Sections 294 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Line Sonapat, District Sonapat (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have made statements voluntarily and they have compromised the matter amicably. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 561, dated 23.12.2013, under Sections 294 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Line Sonapat, District Sonapat and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioner.
