JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in a complaint case bearing No.4 dated 16.02.2012 wherein learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide order dated 09.06.2014, has summoned the petitioner along with other co-accused to face trial for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 201, 203, 205 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (**Annexure P-1**).

The petitioner is the mother of the deceased (minor girl)-Lovepreet Kaur, whereas the complainant is the father. Both were divorced and the deceased was stated to be residing with the mother along with co-accused Sukhmander Singh @ Mander Singh (the paramour of Sukhjit Kaur). She is stated to have died while traveling in a Car with the accused.

The State with regard to the death of Lovepreet Kaur is pursuing the FIR No.59 dated 13.08.2011, under Sections 279, 304-A, 337 and 427, IPC,

registered with Police Station Mukatsar Sadar, District Mukatsar (**Annexure P-4**).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2014 and has been granted interim bail pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 28.05.2015. He further submits that petitioner is willing to face trial.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Iqbal Singh, does not controvert the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, keeping in view the fact as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such she is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.
