The petition is accordingly disposed of with direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Siri Muktsar Sahib, to look into grievances of petitioner as unfolded in representation dated April 22, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and dispose of the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified of this order, and further, if any substance is found, to take action in accordance with law.
